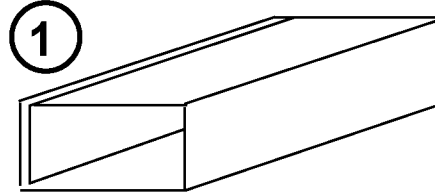


A PRIMER ON BOX DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

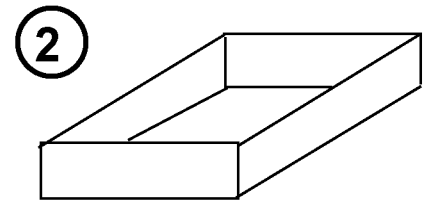
For prototypes and low volume production at any workspace

We start with the axiom in quotes at the right and two drawings that show the two box elements. Every box, as we define them, is either a tray or a sleeve or a combination of the two.

“THERE ARE ONLY TWO BASIC BOX ELEMENTS”

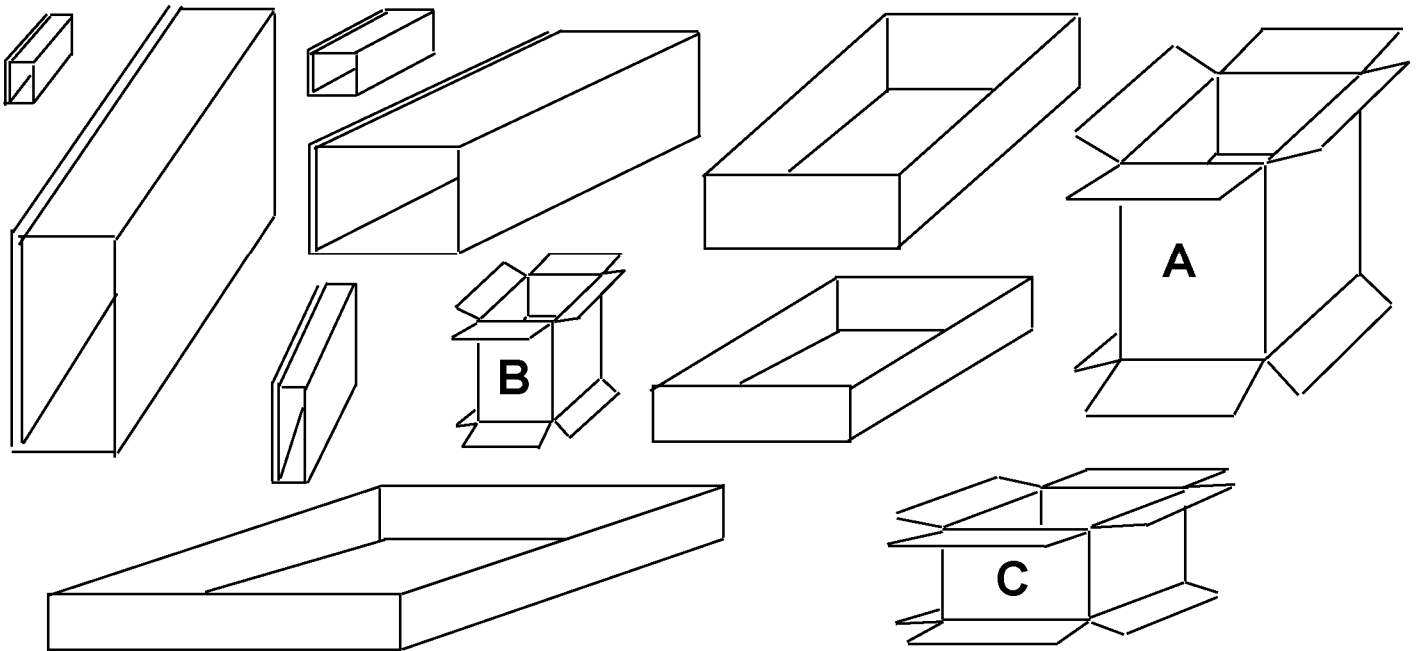


5-Panel Sleeves

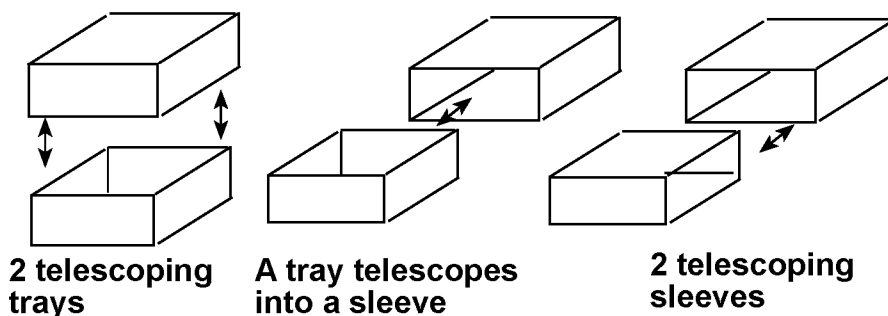


Trays

The two basic box elements can be made in any scale or proportion as shown below, or modified by cutting in **FLAPS** as shown in boxes “A, B & C” below.



The two basic box elements can be combined in many ways to yield all sorts of box styles.



These 3 samples are just a few of various possible combinations. **If you pay attention you will learn how to make them all.**
